- *What is your philosophy of education? Of discipline?*
- *What issues in education are of the greatest concern to you? Why?*
- *Describe the role of the teacher in the learning process.*
- *What is the role of the teacher in the community?*
- *How would you individualize instruction in your classroom?*
- *What specific abilities do you have that would benefit your students?*
- *What prompted you to go into the field of education? Why do you want to teach?*
- *Do you grade on ability or effort? Why?*
- *If you found out the slower learners in the class could not read the grade-level book, what would you do?*
- *Tell me about your student teaching experience.*
- *How do you feel about observations by supervisors and principals? Why?*
- *Are you interested in working with students in some extracurricular activity? If not, why not?*
