On-Campus Interviews (OCIs)

If you can't make it to our campus you can still use the system to set up your phone interviews or use Skype.

The two OCI setup structures are Pre-Select and Resume Collect. They are both on The Gate.

- Pre-Select allows you to screen applications and then invite selected students to schedule an interview.

If you're not sure On-Campus Interviews are right for you choose the Resume Collect option.

- Resume Collect allows you to get started on applicant screening before you lock in a date. Once you determine you would like to conduct OCI's you can upgrade your schedule to Pre-Select and begin inviting students to schedule interviews with you.

Information Table or Session
