- Completed and signed application
- Original high school transcript
- Personal essay (see page 3 for instructions)
- Letter of reference from your high school counselor or one of your senior-year teachers
- Letter from your parent(s) stating what they believe you will get out of going to The Citadel. Their essay should show engagement in your life.

Note: Incomplete application packets will not be considered for award.

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

You are eligible to apply for a scholarship if you meet ALL of the following eligibility requirements:

- you are attending The Citadel Military College of South Carolina
- you are a high school senior graduating from an accredited high school in Florida or North Carolina
- your family income shows a need for tuition assistance
- you have a minimum 2.5/4.0 GPA
- you have a minimum 1500/SAT or 20/ACT score
- you agree by signing this application to release confidential attendance and GPA information.

Note: Meeting eligibility requirements does not guarantee that a scholarship award will be granted.

The Gene and Irene Moody Memorial Scholarship Essay Instructions

A one-page essay is required as part of your application for the Gene and Irene Moody Scholarship award. The essay will be one part of the entire application package that the Scholarship Selection Committee will use to develop its recommendations of award recipients and amounts.

Your essay should explain how you exemplify the qualities and characteristics of Gene and Irene. A brief biography of them is below.

Who are Gene and Irene Moody?

Gene and Irene Moody grew up in the mountains of Hendersonville, North Carolina. They were high-school sweethearts and married in 1958. Gene served his country with the Air Force and then settled back in Hendersonville.

They started their family having two children, Jeff and Mandie, who they raised with great pride. Gene and Irene both worked hard: Gene worked for Lance, Inc. delivering crackers and sweets throughout the area, and Irene worked for the school system as a secretary, guidance counselor, and second mom to all of the children. They were well known and loved by everyone who had the honor of meeting them.

Their son Jeff attended The Citadel in 1977 through graduation in 1980. Jeff would often bring other cadets home with him on the weekends he was allowed to leave campus. Gene and Irene treated them as if they were their own and were a blessing to all!

When Gene and Irene retired, they became even more active in their church and volunteered with Meals on Wheels. During the winter months, they would take their motor home to Fort Meyers Beach, Florida, to vacation at the beach. They enjoyed riding bicycles along the beach and beach access roads. On January 20, 2002—while riding bikes on the sidewalk—a car traveling twice the speed limit veered off the road on to the side walk and struck them head-on ending their lives here on earth. They died as they lived, in love and together.

Gene and Irene are missed by all who knew them and they will not be forgotten thanks to the Moody Memorial Scholarship Fund established at the Community Foundation of Western Nevada. Why Nevada? Jeff Turner, who was one of Jeff Moody's classmates at The Citadel, and his wife Tracy live there and thought enough of Jeff and the connection they had with Jeff's parents to honor them with a memorial fund.

A classmate of Jeff's remembers Gene and Irene this way: "I remember most how Jeff, his sister Mandie, and his Mom and Dad got along. It was as if they were Jeff's college classmates that looked out for him, and they were bent on making sure Jeff did things right. They were very interested in Jeff's success and were a very big part of his life. The best thing is that if Jeff Moody was your friend you automatically got two other great friends for life: Gene and Irene Moody. ... They were probably one of a handful of parents who attended our 2000 class reunion, which I know meant a lot to Jeff. I could see the love Jeff and his Dad had for each other as we all celebrated the win the day we won the 2000 Reunion golf tournament."

Gene and Irene loved The Citadel and everything it stands for. They would be so proud to have their name associated with such a great school. They would also be very happy to know their scholarship fund is helping to put another cadet through this school.
