

**Citadel Summer Study Abroad:  
Code of Conduct**

*By signing two copies of this document, the Citadel Summer Study Abroad Candidate/Participant understands and accepts the code of conduct as explained below. Violation of any rule can result in the IMMEDIATE dismissal from the program and return home at the Program Director's discretion and at the participant's own expense. Absolutely no refunds will be granted to any student dismissed for violating the code described below.*

- 1) Public intoxication is strictly prohibited. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages are allowed on buses, in the institute (except for any party/social sponsored by the institute), or at anytime during excursions. Being blatantly hung over during class or for excursions (to be determined by the Director) is prohibited.
- 2) No fraternizing with minors.
- 3) No cursing or rude behavior. Insubordination or inappropriate conduct toward the Program Director(s), any director from any other college program, the host family, or any instructor or staff member of the host institute is prohibited. Participants must behave in the strictest sense as outlined in the blue book. Any conduct "unbecoming of a cadet" is prohibited.
- 4) Participants must demonstrate respect at all times for all aspects of the host culture.
- 5) Participants must return to host family or designated hostel/hotel every night of the program. In the event of an emergency, participant must notify Program Director(s) of whereabouts.
- 6) Participants will make every attempt to speak in the target language.
