



## JOHNSON HAGOOD STADIUM REVITALIZATION

Johnson Hagood Stadium is the place where The Citadel Family comes home. It is a gathering place for generations of athletes, cadets (past and present), alumni, and the greater Citadel Family to reconnect with the college and the Corps. The expansion and revitalization of the Johnson Hagood football stadium is a project that underscores The Citadel's ongoing commitment to providing the very best possible environment in which its cadet-student-athletes can most successfully compete.

### Features

Some prime features of the modernized facility include:

- New grandstands with premier seating sections
- Enhanced press tower and skyboxes featuring two levels of executive suites
- Luxury club-level seats and a club lounge with catering capabilities
- Two large outdoor club-level terraces overlooking the football field and the Ashley River
- New scoreboard, video screen and sound system
- Spacious, attractive entrance plaza with enhanced accessibility
- Readiness Center for the South Carolina National Guard

### Fast Facts

- **Seating Capacity:** 22,000
- **Multi-Purpose Facility:** The revitalized Johnson Hagood Stadium also houses the South Carolina National Guard Readiness Center. This facility is home to the 218 Infantry Brigade (Mechanized) and becomes an emergency operations center for Charleston and South Carolina during hurricanes, floods and other emergencies. The Citadel and the S.C. National Guard share classrooms and conference rooms within the facility.
- **Total Project Cost:** \$42 million
- **Revenue:**
  - After any debt service is paid, rental income from the facility will generate approximately \$1 million annually to sustain the college's athletic program and augment available athletic scholarship funds.
  - This revenue will enable the college to redirect the unrestricted funds that had been used to support athletic scholarships toward other campus priorities.
- **Scoreboard:** The Citadel currently boasts the largest scoreboard in the state of South Carolina, featuring a huge video board that can display replays, live action and more. Provided by Daktronics, the scoreboard is the width of the field's playing surface and includes a state-of-the-art sound system.
